This Pinot Noir from Talisman comes from the Wildcat Vineyard, located on the western edge of the Sonoma Valley. It opens with gorgeous aromas of dark cherry, ripe raspberries and black fruit along with spices and dried violets. On the plate there is a mix of alluring savory nuances along with ripe red fruits. This is beautifully structured and balanced with velvety tannins backed by a lovely touch of acidity as it heads into the seamless finish. Impressive now and should continue to improve with additional bottle age. (Best 2017-2027) October, 2016

The 2013 Red Dog Vineyard Pinot Noir is a spectacular showing in the vintage. The Vineyard is situated on the northwest side of Sonoma Mountain and benifits from the cool climate of the Pacific. As this begins to open it releases aromas of wild red berries, earthy notes, florals, dark soil, black pepper, and wild dried herbs all soaring from the glass. Overall, it displays a fantastic texture with lots of red fruits on the palate. The finish is vibrant with with lovely acidity and spicy notes lingering.
