### About the Talisman Logo

The Talisman logo is a stylized representation of a Native American medicine wheel. The elements of the medicine wheel represent the circle of life and the four directions, reminding us of our place in the universe. The rays around the medicine wheel represent the sun, which provides energy for life on Earth and ripens grapes, allowing us to revel in the pleasures of life, including fine wine.

### Vineyards and Winemaking

For the sixth time in Talisman's history, we have created and released one of our "outlier" blends. We usually stick to single-vineyard, single-vintage bottlings, but Cuvée No. 6 is a multi-vintage assemblage of wines made from every vineyard from which we source grapes. The appellations include Los Carneros/Napa Valley, Los Carneros/Sonoma, Bennett Valley, Sonoma Coast, Russian River, Sonoma Mountain and Yorkville Highlands in Mendocino County. Fermented by feral yeasts and aged in French oak barrels..

### Tasting Notes

Bright and lively with a wonderful insistent bouquet of plum, raspberry, cola, grilled meat and mandarin peel that compliments the rich ruby garnet hue. This wine is like a party, with a vast range of personalities; hints of licorice, black pepper, black cherry, rocky mineral, vanilla, cream soda, tobacco, cranberry and rose petals... the texture is completely mouth coating and smooth, and the finish lingers on seemingly forever. What a beauty.
