This highly acclaimed vineyard is distinctive in that its terroir is unmistakable; poised at 850-1000' elevation and with very gravelly, rocky, clay loam soil overflowing with quartz, minerals and forests of the Yorkville Highlands in Mendocino County.

The result is a rich, deep graceful and highly nuanced Pinot Noir. A few other stellar producers sourcing from this vineyard include Drew, Toulouse and Williams Selyem.

The Weirs and the Riches longed to work together for several years, and in 2009 were able to begin a delightful partnership based on mutual admiration and the desire to make stunning wine from stunning grapes.
